TAX COLLECTOR

§ 34-1. Office abolished.

The Town Board has determined that it is in the best interest of the Town of Canadice, and does hereby abolish the elected office of Tax Collector as provided for in New York State Town Law § 36 to take effect December 31, 1991.

§ 34-2. Pertinent documents to be transferred; Town Clerk to assume duties.

Pursuant to New York State Town Law § 36, upon expiration of the term of office of the Tax Collector:

- A. Said Tax Collector shall surrender and deliver to the Town Clerk all assessment rolls, books, papers, writings and all other documents and property in possession as pertains to such office.
- B. It shall be the duty of the Town Clerk to collect and receive all state, county and town taxes and assessments that may be levied, and the Town Clerk shall have all the powers and be subject to all the duties of the Tax Collector.¹
